# 05 ORGANIZATION OF ANAK BALI

**3 permanent employees** (President, Secretary, Accountant)  
**1 part-time employee**  
**1 international solidarity volunteer** for global coordination  
**9 field coordinators**

## HIGHLIGHTS

Arrival of **an accounting/administrative assistant in November 2023** (3-month trial period).

A **coordinator at the Dharma Citta Residence** to supervise teenagers and provide young women with a dedicated female contact person.

A **"residential care center" status** for the Dharma Citta residence, obtained following accreditation from Indonesian authorities (Bali Social Department and Regional DINSOS): quarterly visits from authorities and food assistance from the Child Protection Department.

**Implementation of a system to reassess the economic situation of families** (based on government grants obtained) for university students.



# 05 ORGANIZATION OF ANAK BALI

**12 monthly distributions:** letters from sponsors, financial aid for lunch and transportation, individual and family updates, hygiene kit distributions, various donations, health monitoring, festive moments (*songs, dances*), English exchanges (*with the participation of visitors, volunteers, or staff*), introduction of new entrants to the ANAK program.

**Including the annual distribution:** school uniforms (*2 school uniforms, 1 ceremonial, 1 sports outfit, 1 scouting outfit*), shoes, ANAK t-shirt and backpack, supplies, etc.

**Annual boot camp:** immersion of final-year middle school students at the Dharma Citta residence for 5 days: *discovering the residence to help them envision their future life as a high school resident.*



# 06 OUR ACTIONS AROUND EDUCATION

## EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

**English:** courses and Speaking Partner sessions led by high school students from Dharma Citta (*for all middle school students*), **introduction to computers, Balinese dance, Balinese writing, reading** (*purchase of more than 260 books for Pakisan, Sawan, and Pacung*), **drawing, painting, cooking workshop, gardening workshop...**



# 06 OUR ACTIONS AROUND EDUCATION

## TEENAGER EMPOWERMENT

The **organic mini-farm**, a learning space for teenagers, allows growing in small spaces (*vegetable garden*), raising 2 pigs and about twenty chickens, converting kitchen waste into solid or liquid organic fertilizer, and using water from the mini phyto-purification plant for irrigation.

## HIGHLIGHTS

**Cultivation of an adjacent 500m<sup>2</sup> plot** in addition to the original 260m<sup>2</sup> of the mini-farm program.

**3 compost bins.**

**Non-GMO seeds** made available by the SEED FOOD PROJECT association during an information day on organic farming.



# 06 OUR ACTIONS AROUND EDUCATION

## TEENAGER EMPOWERMENT

**"Entry into working life" workshops:** writing CVs and cover letters, role-playing and simulations, mock job interviews.

**Intensive English and computer training.**

**"Speaking partner" program:** English conversation workshops (30-min video calls) with members of the Rotary Club Honolulu, then with Swiss high school students. These workshops were then replicated by teenagers for all middle school students at the socio-cultural centers and intervention villages.

**Entrepreneurship workshops:** sewing, basic mechanics, intensive English, applied computing, preparation and sale of Balinese snacks and pastries, graphic design...



# 06 OUR ACTIONS AROUND EDUCATION

## EXPERIENCE SHARING & SKILLS TRANSFER

**Lucie, physiotherapist:** presented her profession and provided an introduction to certain basic care practices (*sprains, menstrual pain, lower back pain*) over one week.

**Marc Esposito, director of "Toute la beauté du Monde" (2004):** film screening and Q&A in English.

**David Greilsammer, pianist and conductor:** music discovery workshops organized with the support of the Alliance Française de Bali.

**Arianti (former sponsored child, seamstress):** presented her profession and coached a final-year high school student for seamstress training.

**Wayan (former sponsored child, team leader in a restaurant):** shared his experience entering professional life, the challenges faced, highlighted skills gained at the home, and motivated the youth.

**Oka (former sponsored child, driver):** shared his experience in tourism, focused on the importance of learning English, highlighted the advantages of being self-employed, and motivated young people to keep pushing their professional skills further.



# 07 OUR ACTIONS AROUND THE CENTERS

Purchase of bicycles thanks to funds raised by Team Squirrel (competitors in the Raid Amazon: a race in Sri Lanka). 13 bicycles allowing children to get to school and participate in extracurricular activities.

## CENTERS

**Amed:** renovation of blinds, ceiling repair, installation of a water pump, moth treatment, and dishware renewal...

**Pakistan:** purchase of furniture...

**Sawan:** purchase of furniture and a whiteboard...

**Pacung:** purchase of furniture, renovation of the bibliomobile (a mobile library to bring books to children in villages far from ANAK centers)...

**All centers:** geographical maps (world, Indonesia) and new "Yayasan/Association ANAK" signs at the entrance of the socio-cultural centers...

## DHARMA CITTA RESIDENCE

Purchase of 2 washing machines, construction of a shelter and paving for laundry drying, installation of an outdoor sink for washing large kitchen utensils and a wall dish rack, repair of one of the sewing machines, installation of a video surveillance system (with 6 cameras).



# 08 OUR ACTIONS AROUND THE ENVIRONMENT

**Regular waste collection actions** at each center.

Participation of teenagers in **reforestation in the Sambangan forest**.

Awareness-raising on **reducing plastic waste** (*screening of the film Pulau Plastik, debate, and workshops on the lifespan of plastic waste*).

Training of youth in **organic farming and livestock rearing** (*organic techniques, organic fertilizers...*).

**Selective sorting and use of organic waste** workshops (*composting, making cleaning products and liquid soap...*).

# 09 OUR ACTIONS AROUND FAMILIES

**Annual meeting with parents and local authorities.**

**Identification of families in difficulty** and joint search for solutions with administrative and customary authorities.

Implementation of **concrete actions to resolve serious problems** (informing and involving sponsors).

**Distribution of food aid.**

**Drilling at Amed and reforestation of the hillside** in consultation with local authorities to define their participation in the work.

**Restocking of first aid kits** during distributions.

**Hypnotherapy session at Dharma Citta:** identifying and managing emotions — introduction to self-hypnosis.

**"Mirror on Oneself" workshop at Sawan and Dharma Citta** with Éléna, an Italian artist.

**Field statistical analysis & "Entry into working life" English workshop** with Mathilde, a master's student in social geography.

**Pedagogical analysis of teaching, monitoring of coordinator and facilitator activities, professional situation workshops, library work (book sorting, classification, reading interest survey) and environmental awareness** with Stéphanie during a professional internship (high school teacher in Switzerland).

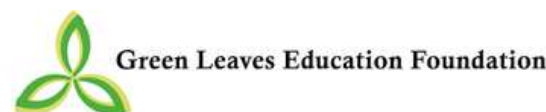

# 04 BIG PROJECT: THE ANAK HIGH SCHOOL

*Accredited by Indonesian authorities, within the Dharma Citta residence*

## OBJECTIVES

1. Allow high school students **to follow a curriculum better suited to higher education** (*post-baccalaureate*) or **professional integration**.
2. **Offer quality education** meeting the needs of local recruiters:
  - An academic curriculum allowing access to university studies.
  - Technical training to access vocational programs or entry into working life.
  - Personalized support and follow-up taking into account each person's skills and aspirations.
3. **Enable young people to access quality, skilled employment.**

**Help them break free from social determinism!**



# 04 BIG PROJECT: THE ANAK HIGH SCHOOL

*Accredited by Indonesian authorities, within the Dharma Citta residence*

## PROJECT DETAILS

- **3 classes:** grades 10, 11 & 12, corresponding to 10th, 11th, and 12th grade in France, with small class sizes.
- **Academic courses in the morning** (*economics, geography-history, mathematics, physics-chemistry, biology, civic education...*).
- **Practical workshops in the afternoon** (*intensive English, applied computing, organic farming, pastry/snack cooking, sewing, electronics, plumbing & air conditioning*).
- **2 mandatory extracurricular activities:** sport and art.
- **Personalized vocational training** (tourism professions...).
- **Career guidance workshops:** writing CVs and cover letters, mock job interviews.
