- 4 technical tutors at the high school

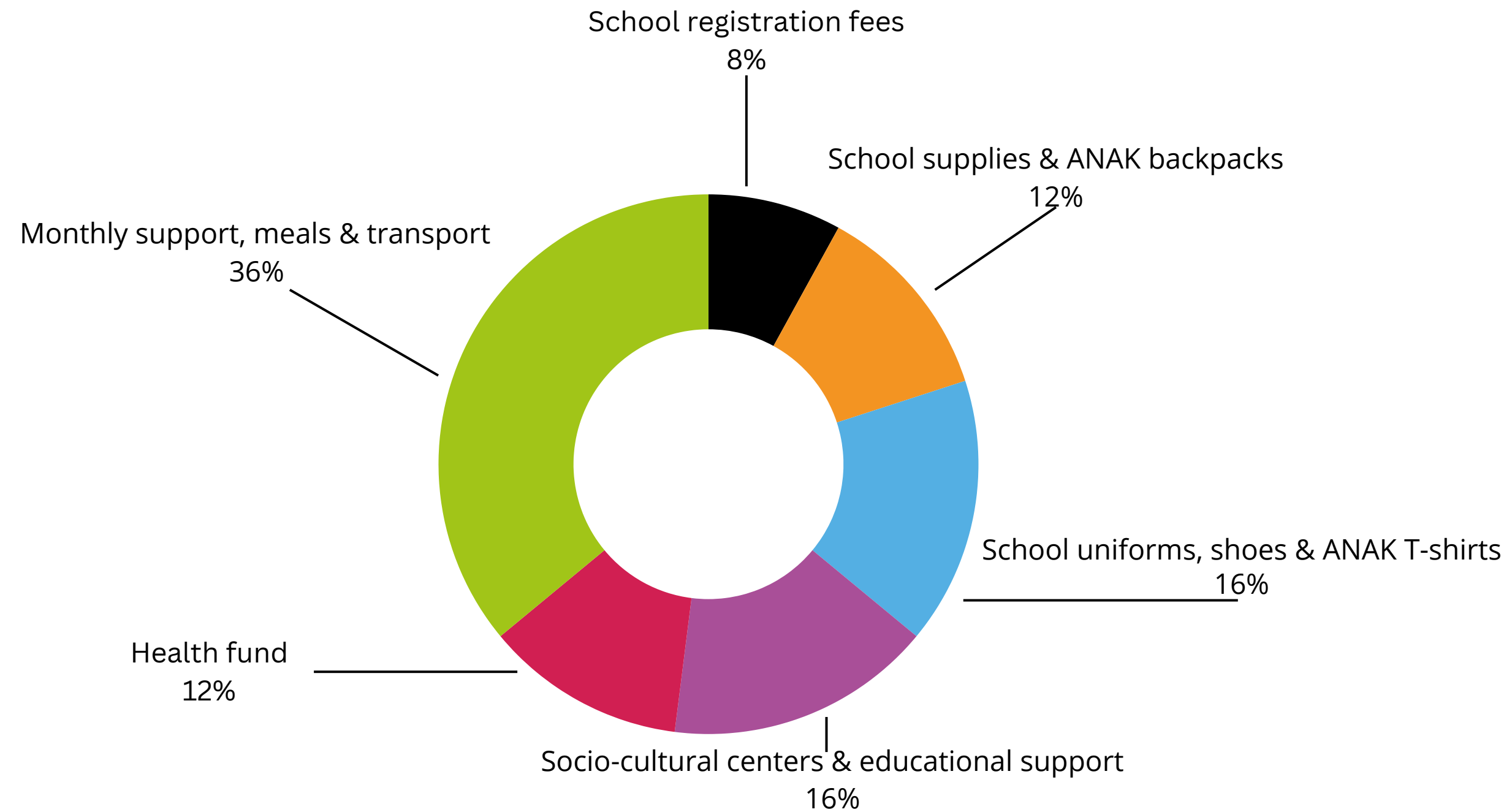

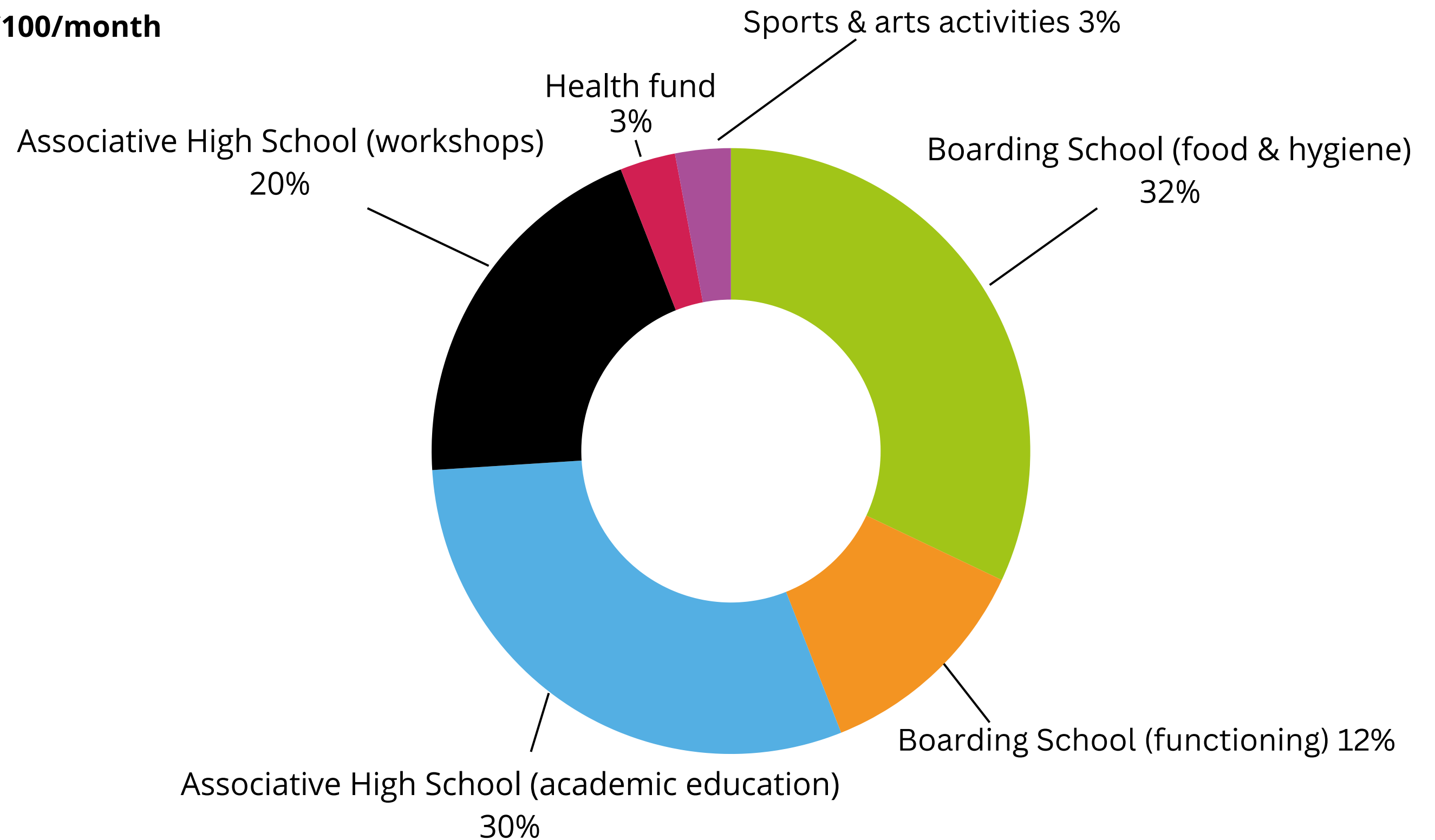
EVERYTHING FOR THE CHILDREN

Primary & Middle School Sponsorship: €25/month



EVERYTHING FOR THE YOUTH

High school sponsorship: €100/month



KEY MOMENTS OF SUPPORT

Throughout the year, we organise special **distribution events** in the villages **to strengthen the link with the children and their families and guarantee comprehensive support:** educational, health, etc.

- **11 monthly distributions:** letters from sponsors, food aid, school follow-ups, health & family updates
- **1 annual distribution:** 5 mandatory school uniforms & full school supply kits



AN ASSOCIATIVE HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE FUTURE

ANAK offers a **comprehensive, professionally-oriented training program** combining academic teaching, practical experience and **support in finding a job.**

The main objective: to provide each young person with the keys to successful integration into the world of work, through work placements, career workshops, inspiring encounters and personalised support.

Associative high school

Education recognised by the Indonesian Ministry of Education, geared towards post-baccalaureate success or access to employment.

An organic mini-farm

Learn to cultivate, raise and respect nature in a sustainable way.

4 vocational workshops

Cooking, sewing, web design, mechanics: develop practical, certifiable skills.



WELCOME TO DHARMA CITTA BOOTCAMP

Every year, ANAK organises a **one-week integration bootcamp** to welcome new middle school students to the Dharma Citta boarding school.

This is a great opportunity for young people to:

- Discover community life.
- Learn the rules of life in the hostel.
- Bond with their elders and the support team.
- And above all, have fun!

OUR GOALS

- **Provide each child and young person with personalised support**, with kindness and respect, taking into account their history, and aspirations.
- **Give them self-confidence.**
- **Offering them a complete, high-quality career path** to open up all the possibilities for them.
- **Breaking the intergenerational predetermination of the poverty of their environment of origin**, not through assistance, but through education and support.
- **Giving wings to every child and young person**, so that they dare to dream, choose, build and carry out their own life project.



OUR ACTIONS - EDUCATION

In 2024, ANAK continued to place education at the heart of its action. From schooling to cultural awakening, every child in primary and secondary school has benefited **from comprehensive support to learn, grow and open up to the world.**

Schooling

- Uniforms, school equipment, transport and lunch.

Extra-curricular activities: **more than 2,200 hours**

- English, IT, Balinese dance and writing, reading
- Cooking workshops, making eco-enzymes, yoga, etc.
- Discovery of the natural heritage around the villages where we work

Access to reading

- **128 hours** of mobile libraries in the villages of Pacung and surrounding areas

Local culture

- **15 Balinese dance performances** by children at village ceremonies



OUR ACTIONS - EDUCATION

Dharma Citta is much more than a boarding school: it's a place where young people can live together, take responsibility and develop their potential. In 2024, the boarding school strengthened its participative approach, encouraging autonomy, social integration and the construction of future projects.

Living together and putting down roots locally

- A community lifestyle based on respect, sharing and participation
- Involvement in neighbourhood life: participation in local ceremonies and the National Day
- Presentation of the home in English to visitors, partner members and sponsors
- An integration bootcamp for the 13 middle school pupils in the boarding school as they prepare to enter high school.



OUR ACTIONS - EDUCATION AFTER 1 YEAR

On 15 July 2024, ANAK reached a major milestone with the opening of its associative high school approved by the Indonesian authorities. The school offers a comprehensive, high-quality education focused on post-baccalaureate success and professional integration, in a caring and demanding environment.

Academic course

- **4.320 hours** of academic teaching, with an active and adapted pedagogy.
- **242 hours** of intensive English and **132 hours** of "Speaking Partner" programme with Sevenoaks School and Galou.
- **100%** pass rate at baccalauréat level.
- Preparation for university entrance examinations..

Workshops & practical skills

- **518 hours** of vocational workshops with skills certificates (cookery, mechanics, organic mini-farm, web design, sewing)
- **220 hours** of business creation workshops
- **393 hours** of professional integration workshops (CV writing, interview simulations, role-playing)



OUR ACTIONS - EDUCATION

Immersion & career guidance

- **19** final-year students on work experience at Café Léo: discovering careers (cooking, service, pastry-making)
- **35 hours** of training in organic farming in Java with BSM @Bayu (4 or 5 young people)

Openness and balance

- **352 hours** of sporting and artistic activities to encourage young people's all-round development.





OUR ACTIONS - EDUCATION

In 2024, the young people supported by ANAK brilliantly passed a key stage in their careers. Thanks to their determination and personalised support, some were able to go on to university or the professional world.

13 young people graduated from public education. 5 enrolled at university (1 in management, 1 in nursing school, 1 future nursery teacher, 1 future English teacher, 1 in hotel management school). **8 in professional training courses. 1 alumni admitted to the Bali Culinary Pastry School for an 18-month training course in cooking**, with the aim of becoming a chef.

OUR ACTIONS - HEALTH

Health is a **major priority** in the overall support provided to children and sponsored young people.

Awareness-raising and prevention

- Workshops on sex education and violence/abuse prevention.
- Feminine hygiene workshops, led by Merti (sponsored by ANAK, studying to become a nurse).

Medical follow-up

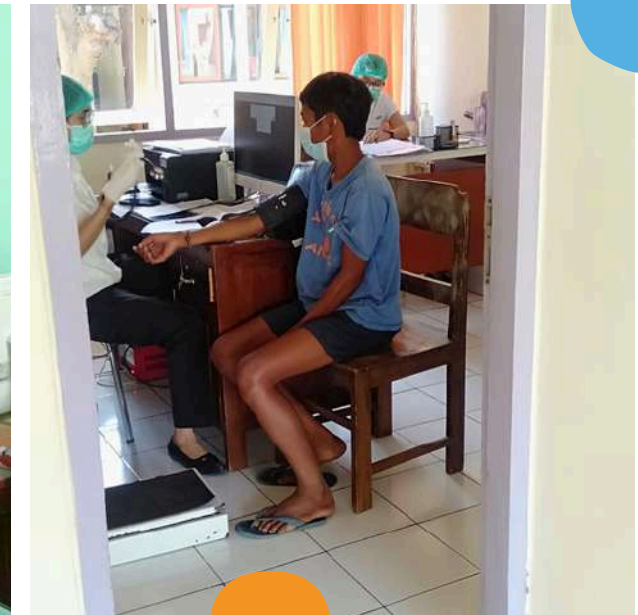
- Medical check-ups for all sponsored children and teenagers.
- Regular replenishment of first-aid kits in the centres and at the Dharma Citta home.

Material aid and hygiene

- Distribution of hygiene kits (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, etc.).

Medical support and emergency aid

- Provision of care not covered by the health card.
- Emergency assistance for children, young people or families (hospitalisation, accident, etc.).



OUR ACTIONS - FAMILY SUPPORT

Drilling carried out in Amed, in partnership with the Karangasem district, **benefiting more than 1.800 people.**

Regular meetings with families and local authorities to raise awareness of the importance of education.

Identification and support for families in serious difficulty, in conjunction with the administrative and customary authorities.

Distribution of food aid with the support of Aviacó.

Installation of Nazava water filters for each family supported.

OUR ACTIONS - ENVIRONMENT

Waste collection organised in each of the villages where we work.

Major operation in Amed: over 160 participants with Bali Autrement and Peduli Alam.

Raising awareness of the need to reduce plastic waste among children, young people and families.

Training young people in sustainable farming practices: organic farming and responsible animal husbandry.

Workshops on selective sorting and recycling of organic waste.

Construction of "fishdomes" to encourage the regeneration of coral and provide shelter for fish (Pacung).

Organic eco-enzyme soap-making workshop.



INVESTMENTS FOR THE FUTURE

In 2024, ANAK has invested in its infrastructure to meet the need for development, but also to enhance its quality and guarantee a safe and suitable environment for everyone.

Development:

- Purchase of 4 plots of land to support the association's growth and future projects.
- Construction of a teachers' room at Dharma Citta.
- Installation of a roof for the "laundry - ironing" area at the boarding school.
- Installation of a roof/paravent at the Sawan centre.

Security and maintenance:

- Installation of video surveillance in the Pakisan, Amed and Pacung centres, as well as at the office.
- Various repairs in the centres and office to ensure a high-quality welcome.

HIGHLIGHTS & EVENTS OF 2024

Throughout 2024, ANAK has stepped up its **educational, cultural, sporting and solidarity initiatives** to enrich the lives of the children and of the young people it sponsors.

These initiatives have **stimulated their curiosity, boosted their self-confidence, encouraged intercultural exchanges and created solid bridges** with our partner schools and committed artists.

From art to the environment, via to sport, music and health, each activity contributed to making 2024 **a dynamic year, rich in learning and emotions.**

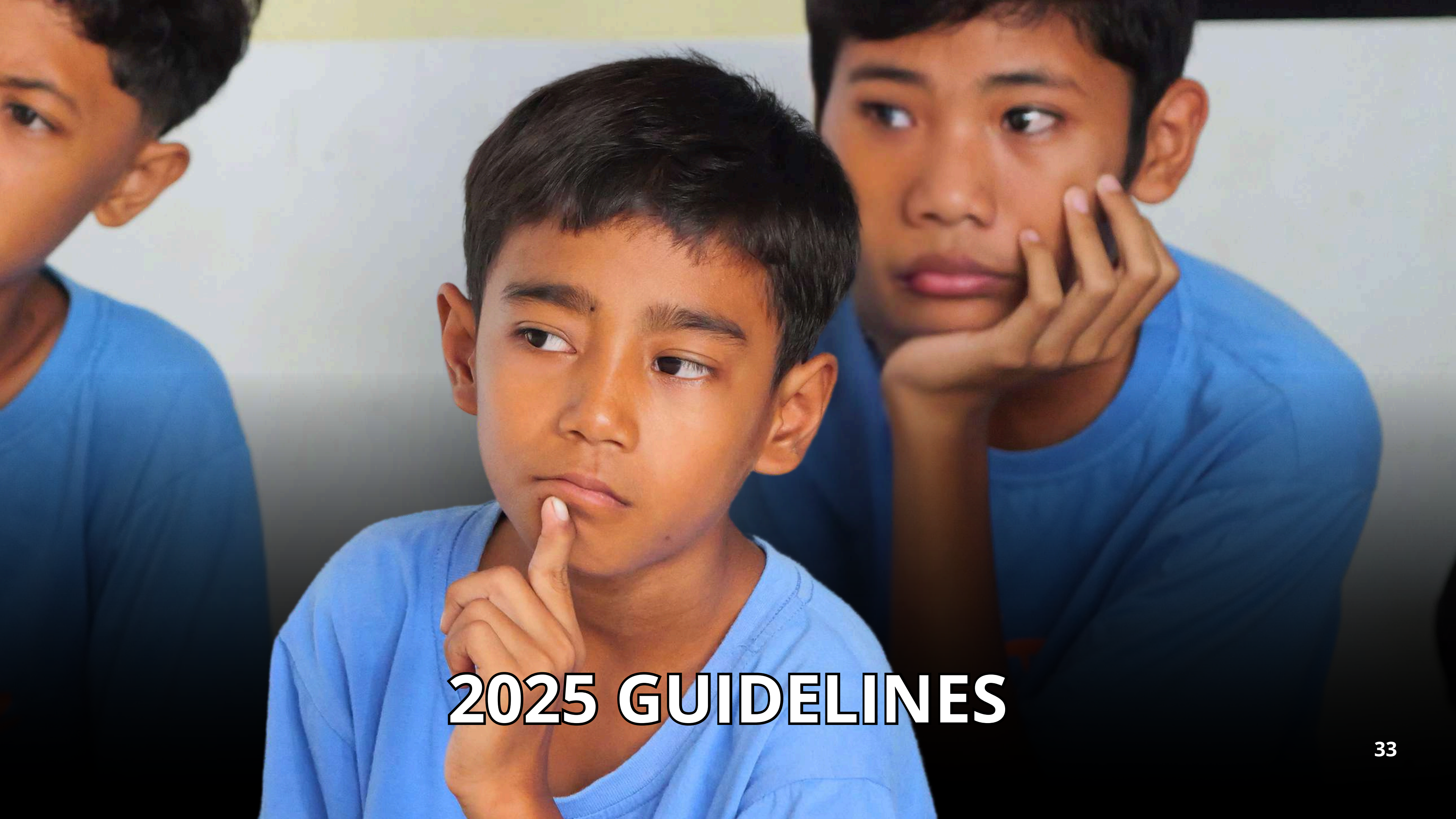

FORWARD-THINKING PROJECTS

In 2025, ANAK will continue its development with concrete **projects** in favour of **the environment, education and the autonomy of young people**, but also plans to **strengthen its local and international partnerships**.

Environment & infrastructure

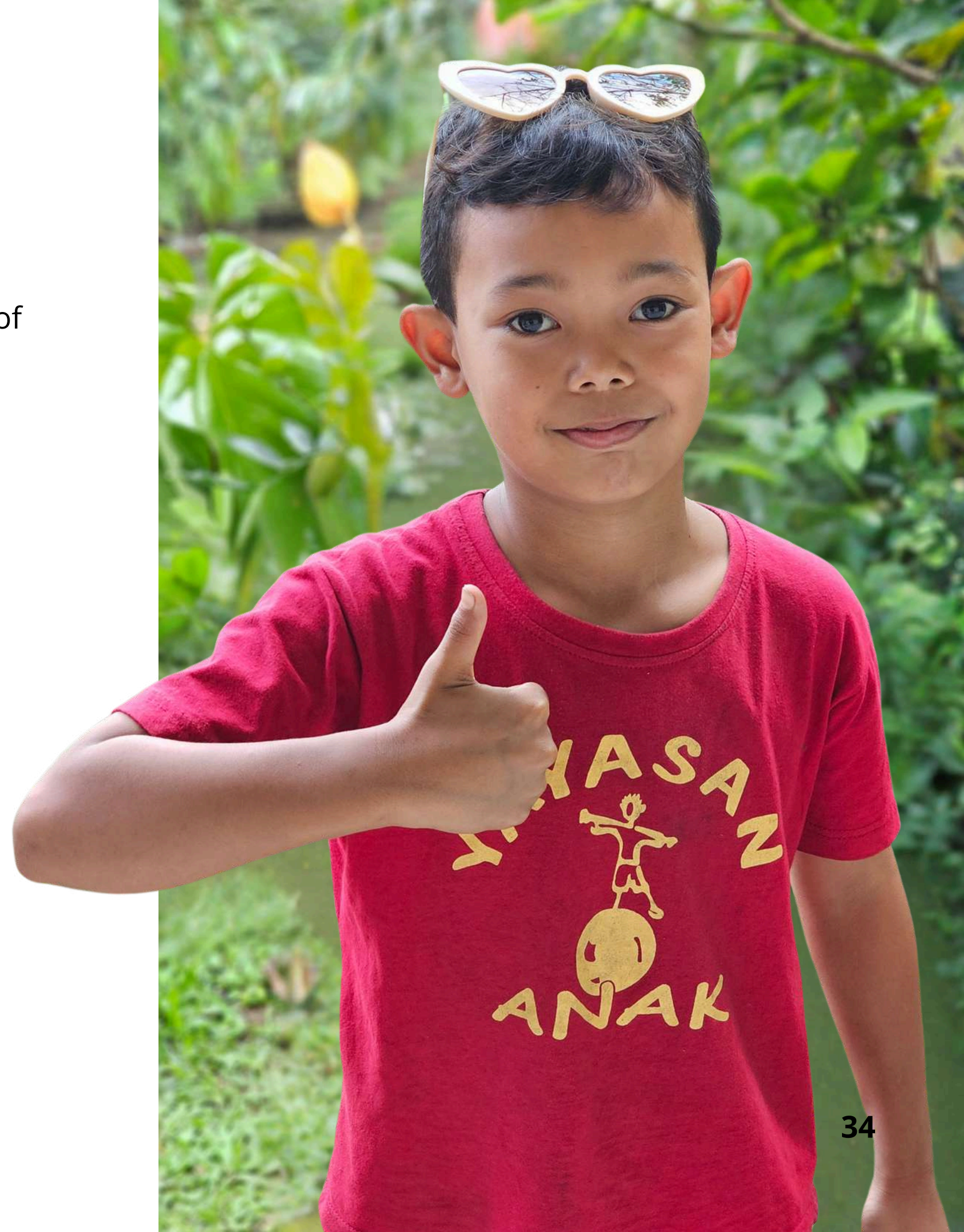
- Reforestation of a hill in Amed.
- Extension of the Dharma Citta boarding school: new boys' dormitories + workshops and sales area.
- Construction of a new centre in Panji Anom.

Training & immersion

- Professional training courses for young people.
- Immersion courses in English.

Strengthening partnerships

- Arrival of a VIS dedicated to developing partnerships in Bali.
- Redesign of the website underway.
- Development of partnership with Bali Autrement.



FORWARD-THINKING PROJECTS

ANAK **continues and strengthens its actions** to provide ever more appropriate support.

Centres & foyer

- Continuation of activities in the socio-cultural centres and boarding school.
- Purchase of books to enrich the libraries.
- “Menstruation workshop” run by Merti (student nurse) for DC high school girls.
- Study Tour to Denpasar Park for all the children.
- Distribution of Nazava water filters to all new arrivals.

Dharma Citta boarding school

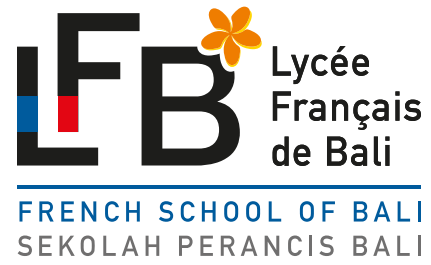
- Installation of new filtration tanks for the mini-water treatment plant.
- Recruitment of 2 coordinators to supervise the teenagers on a daily basis.

Associative high school

- One-month career discovery course for final-year students (at the start of the school year).
- Adaptation of workshops to the realities of the local market.
- Creation of the "Green Class" (eco-responsible class).
- Search for new customers for products from the workshops.
- Launch of encoding workshops.



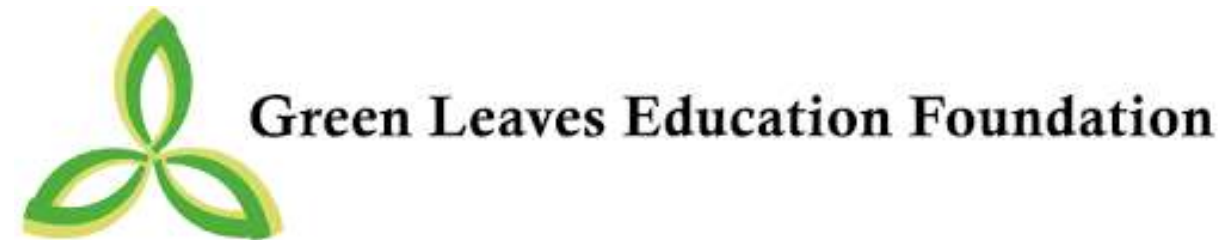
