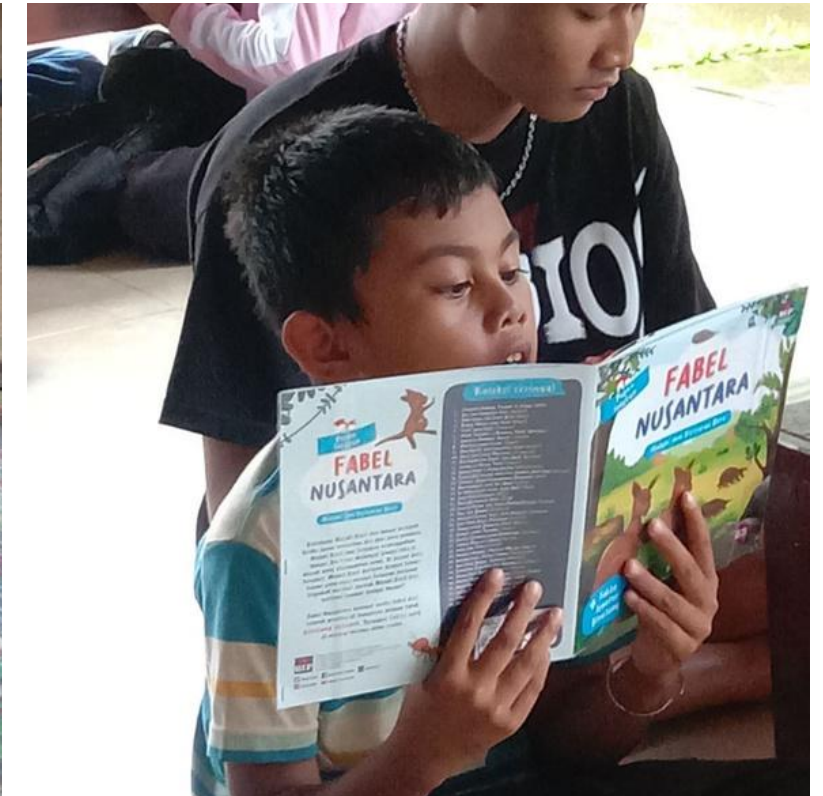

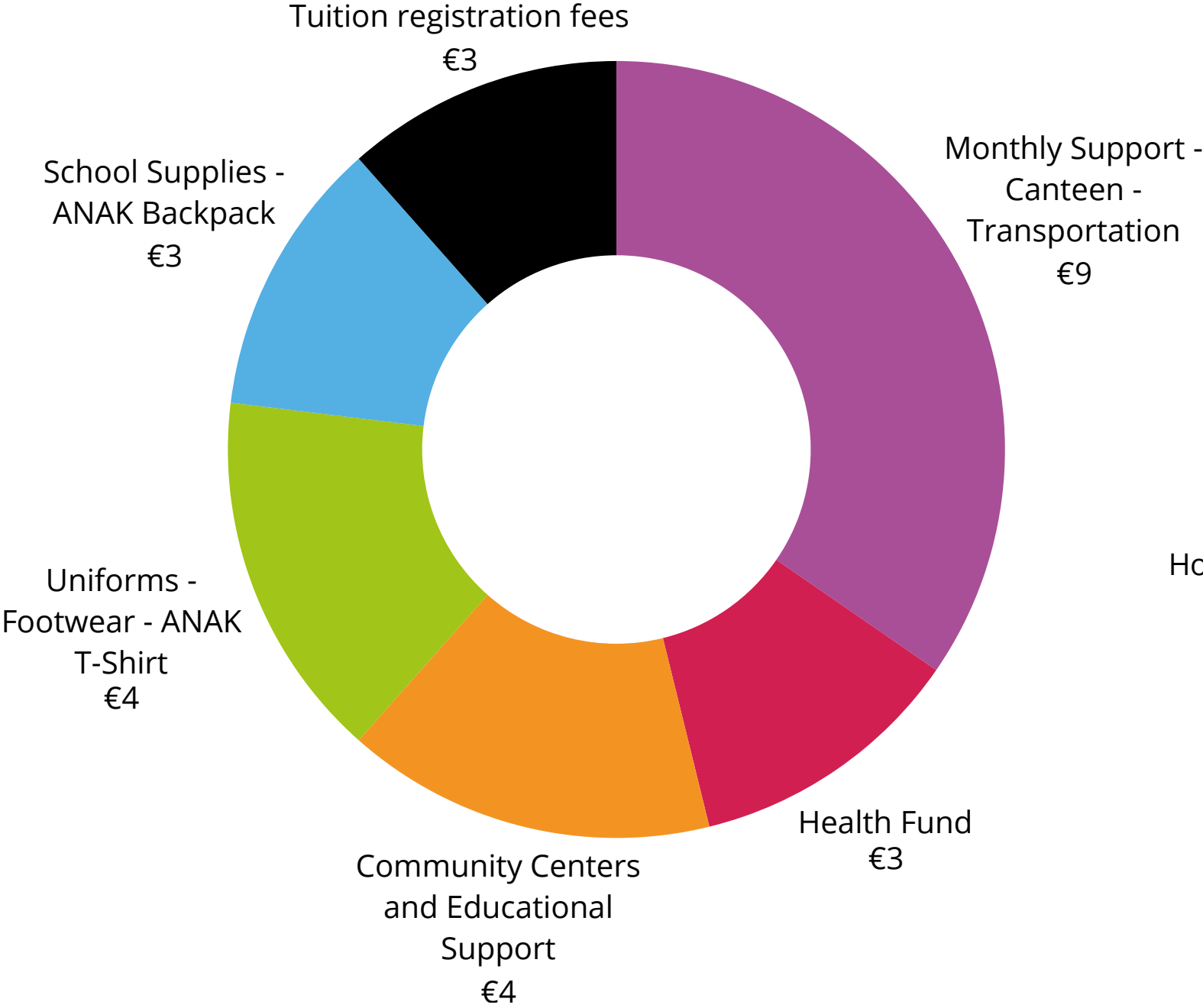

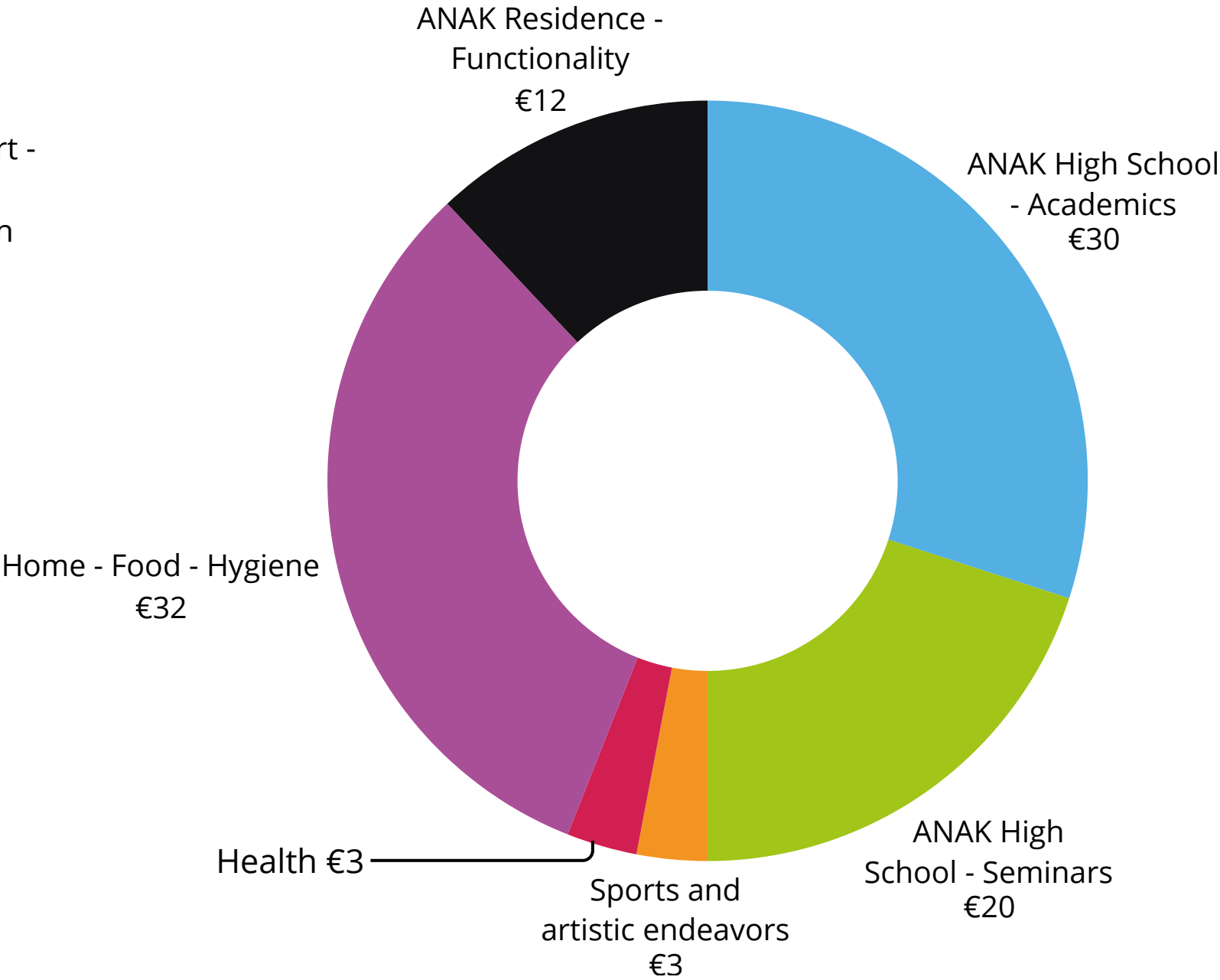

2025 - Primary - Middle School Sponsorship (€25/month)

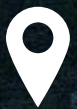
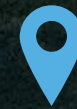


2025 - High School Sponsorship (€100/month)

# OUR ACTIONS - ACCESS TO EDUCATION

## THE DHARMA CITTA RESIDENCE

New

- **Welcoming two middle school students to the residence**  
(complex familial circumstances)
- **Coexisting and establishing local roots:**
  - A communal lifestyle founded on respect and collaboration and engagement.
  - Engagement in the community includes participation in local ceremonies, National Day celebrations, clean-up initiatives, and the sale of services and products from vocational workshops to residents.
  - Presentation of the residence in English to visitors, partners, members, and sponsors.
  - Integration bootcamp for the 14 middle school students residing at the facility in preparation for their transition to high school.



# OUR ACTIONS - ACCESS TO EDUCATION

## A NEWLY CONSTRUCTED SPORTS FIELD IN DHARMA CITTA

- A multi-sport facility for the youth of the residence.
- Engaging in sports as part of extracurricular activities or during weekends.
- Sports classes are conducted by external instructors who utilize the field as a facility.
- Coordinating events or workshops.

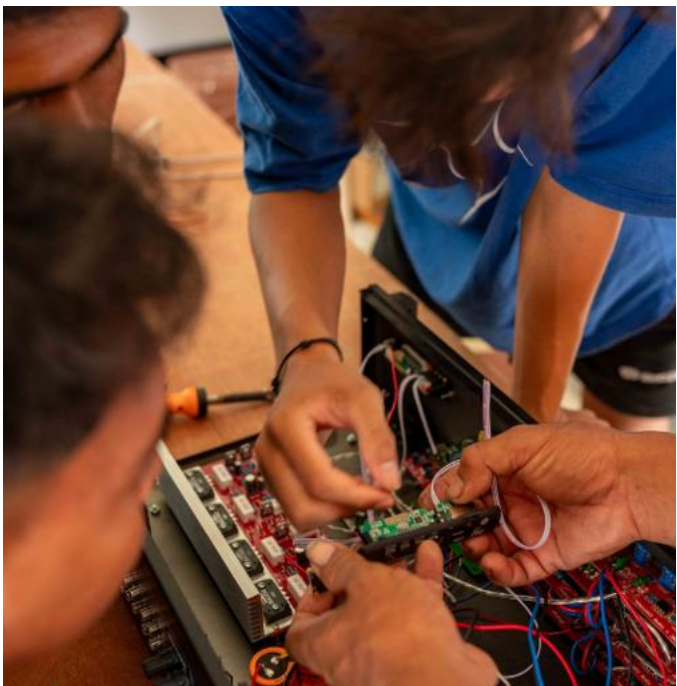


# OUR INITIATIVES - ACCESS TO EDUCATION

# OUR INITIATIVES - ACCESS TO EDUCATION

## ANAK HIGH SCHOOL

- **Professional workshops (480 hours)**

- A small organic farm**

- Learning to cultivate, nurture, and honor nature in a sustainable manner.

- 5 vocational workshops**

- Culinary arts, tailoring, web development, automotive repair, and aesthetics/spa: develop tangible and verifiable skills.

- **Practical competencies**

- 183 hours** of professional integration workshops, including CV writing, interview simulations, and role-playing.

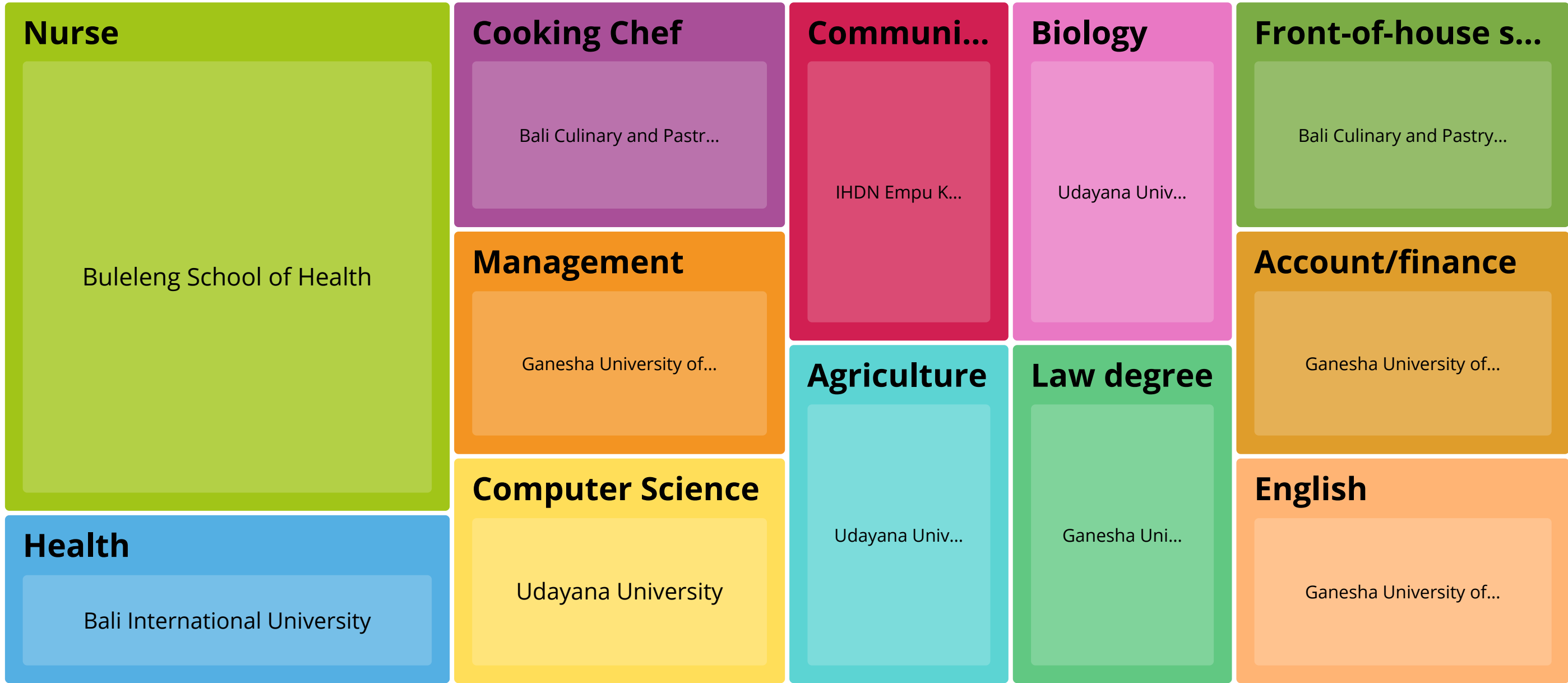

# OUR ACTIONS - HEALTH

- Collaboration with our university nurses for **awareness and prevention**:  
Sexuality education and prevention seminars.  
Violence and Abuse Awareness.  
Workshops on Feminine Hygiene.
- **Medical oversight**  
For all sponsored children and adolescents.  
Visual acuity evaluation by Bilitys, volunteer. New
- **Material assistance and hygiene**  
Consistent restocking of first aid kits in centers and Dharma Citta Residence.  
Distributes hygiene kits, including toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, and other essentials.
- **Medical support and emergency assistance**  
Coverage for services not included under the health card.  
Emergency assistance for children, adolescents, or families (hospitalization, accidents, etc.).



# OUR ACTIONS - FAMILY SUPPORT

- **Regular meetings with families and local authorities** to promote awareness of the significance of education.
- **Identification and assistance of families in significant distress**, in collaboration with administrative and customary authorities.
- **Distribution of food assistance** as required.
- **Installation of Nazava water filters** for every supported family.

# OUR ACTIONS - THE ENVIRONMENT

- **Waste collection** is organized in each intervention village.
- **Raising awareness regarding the reduction of plastic waste** among children, adolescents, and families.
- **Educating youth in sustainable agricultural methodologies:** organic agriculture and ethical animal husbandry.
- Workshops for the sorting and **recycling of organic waste**
- **Mini waste incinerator** at Dharma Citta New
- **Workshop on crafting soap with organic eco-enzymes** at the Dharma Citta residence.

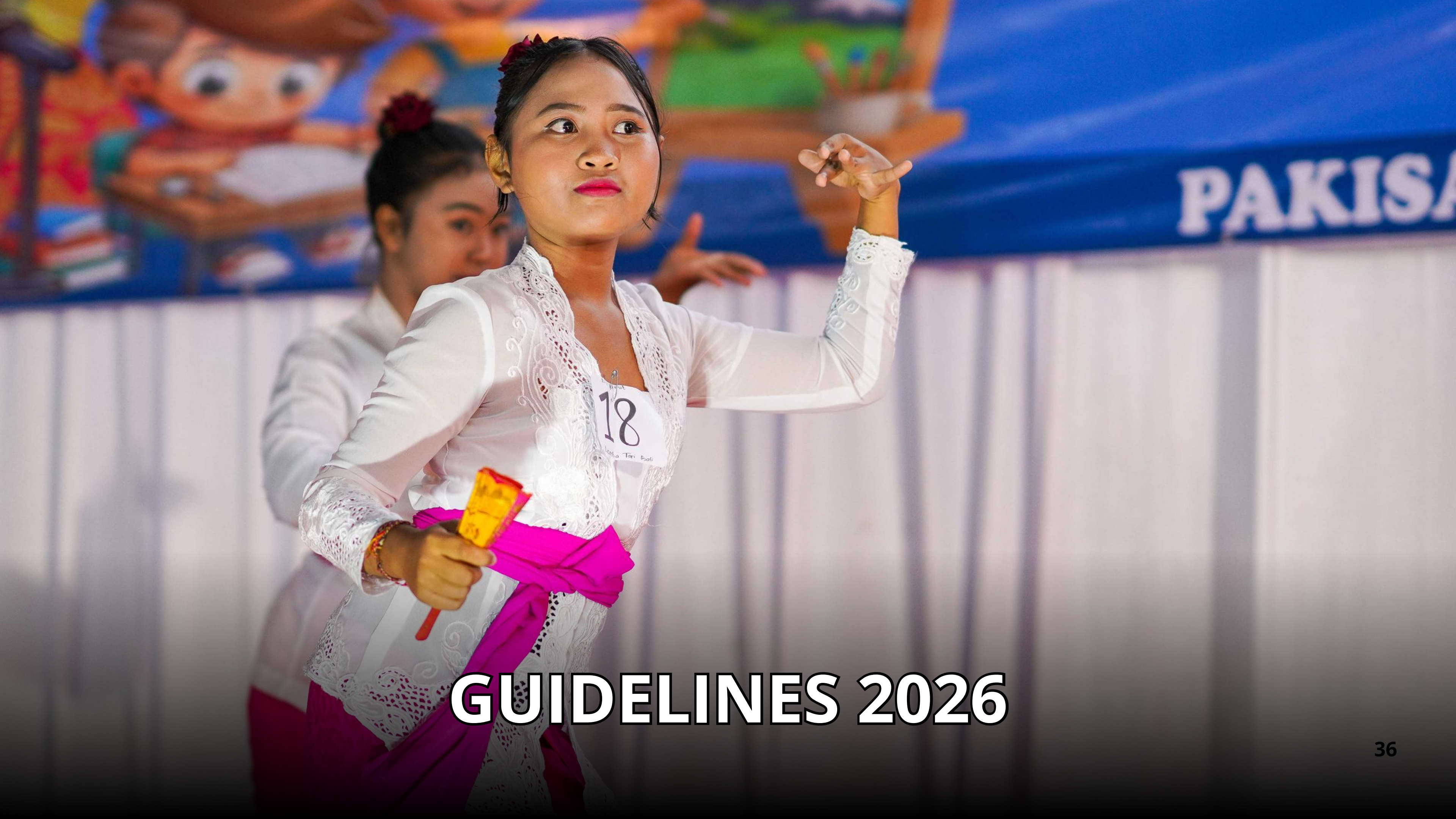

# PROJECTS WITH SIGNIFICANT POTENTIAL

## ● In France

Internal regulations that evolve in response to ANAK and global developments of today.

A newly established professional organization in accounting and finance. outsourced by implementing a skills-based volunteering program.

Another year of collaboration with the SCD for a VSI position in Bali focused on fostering partnerships between France and Bali.

## ● In Bali

Enhancing the quality of educational support provided to children and young people through the gradual integration of ANAK alumni.



# PROJECTS WITH SIGNIFICANT POTENTIAL

## ● **Access to education - Primary - Middle School**

Implementation of a comprehensive educational program: enhancement fundamental education (literacy, numeracy) and the acquisition of English under the supervision of the Academic Director of the high school.

Acquisition of a school vehicle designated for the transportation of children from the villages of Banglé and Tukad Basé to the socio-cultural center in Amed.

## ● **Access to Education - High School**

Pursuing new internship opportunities.

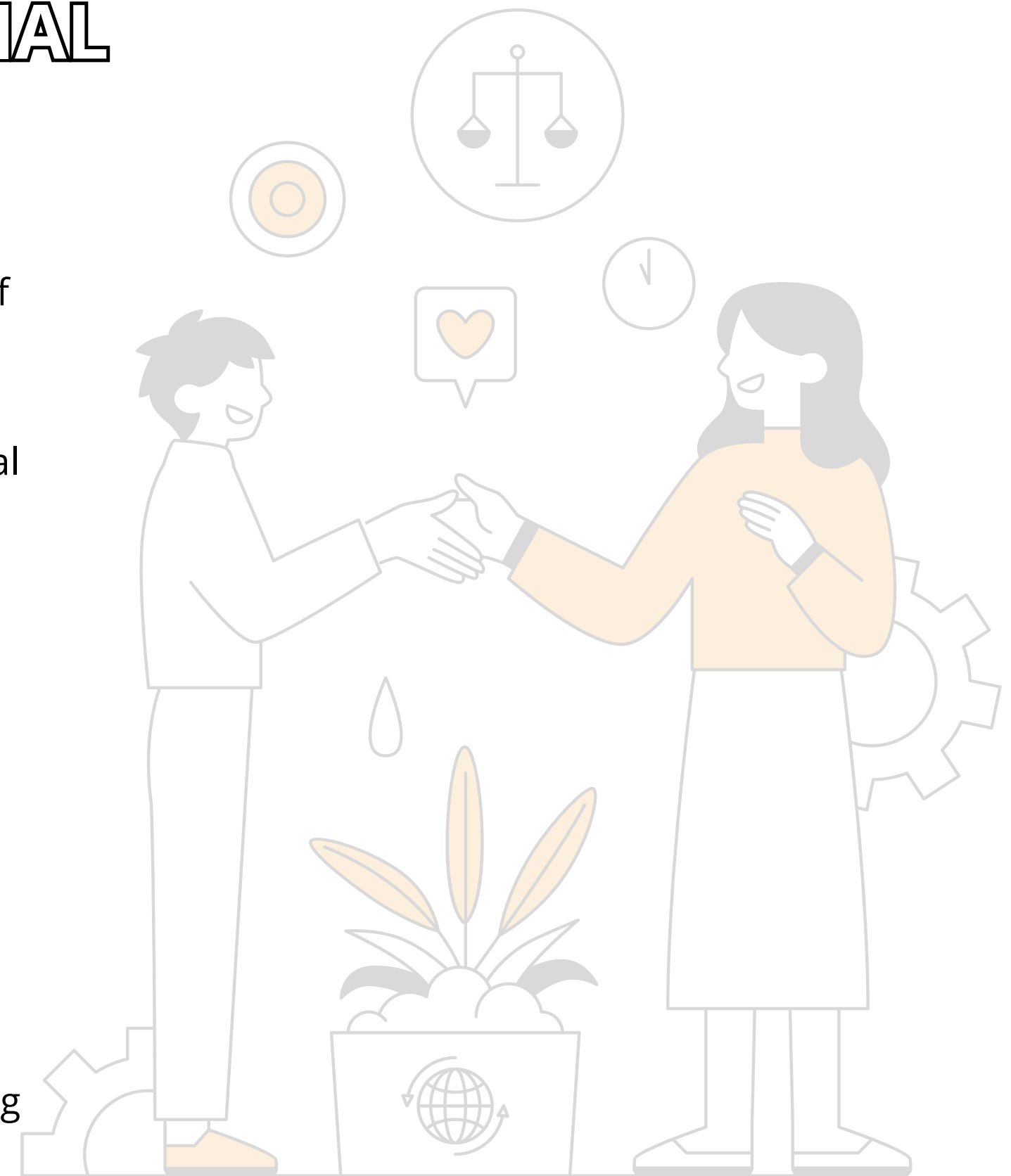
Introduction to careers associated with air conditioning maintenance and swimming pool water treatment.

## ● **Post-baccalaureate studies and professional integration:**

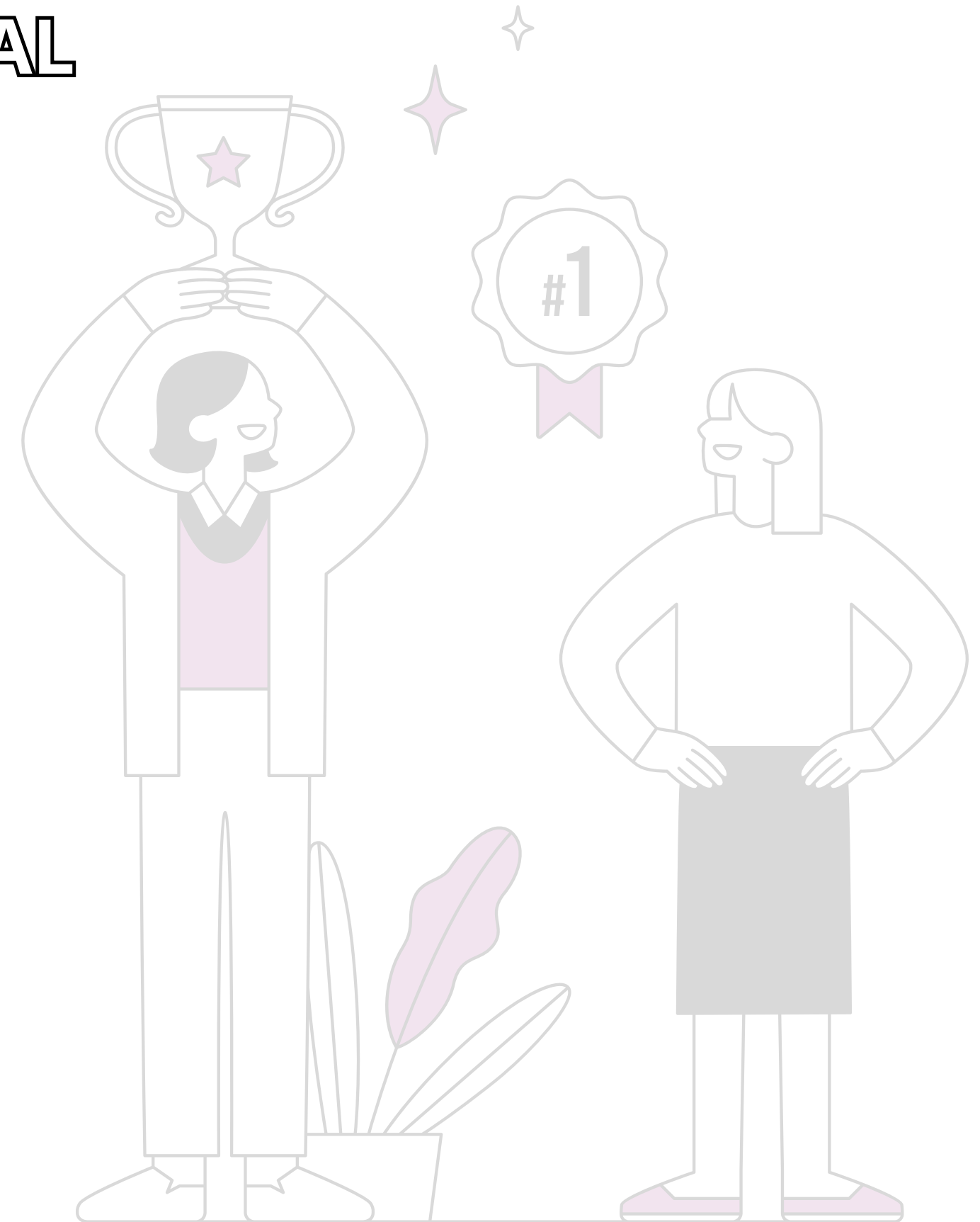
Two candidates seek admission to the Bali Culinary Pastry School.

- **Maintenance of socio-cultural centers and the Dharma Citta residence.**



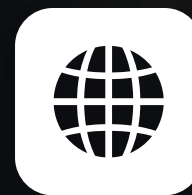
# PROJECTS WITH SIGNIFICANT POTENTIAL

  - Distinguishing study areas from living spaces fosters coherence, tranquility, and productivity.
- **Building configuration:**
  - Three classrooms (grade 10 - grade 11 - grade 12).
  - Three rooms for professional workshops.
  - Staff lounge.
  - Administrative office.
